- I have several students on an “inactive list”, How do I “reactivate them”. –
Logged into Web Reports for LaFayette, Printed out the Reports Inactivation Report and worked with Patsy on getting the students reactivated in Medicaid Direct.

Q & A: Districts asked questions:

LaFayette: The district had gone without Medicaid Billing staff for 2 years. This had caused some students to be placed on the “Inactive Report” in Web Reports. This is a unique situation. Patsy pushed those students through, generated another MD File and submitted to Medweb for the 6/4 collection.
